

## **ABOUT CalEHP**

#### **Funding**

- The California Electric Homes program (CalEHP) is administered by the California Energy Commission (CEC)
  - authorized by Assembly Bill (AB) 137 (Ting, Chapter 77, Statues of 2021)
  - funds were appropriated in the Budget Act of 2021
- \$58M total available funding that including \$10M for energy storage
- Funds are available for projects completing through 2027
- Incentives decrease over time

## **CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC HOMES**





**Summary:** Incentives for all-electric residential new construction market rate properties

#### **Eligibility:**

Territory: All of California



- **Building Type:** Single family, duplexes, triplexes, condominiums, low-rise and high-rise multifamily, ADUs, modular and manufactured homes
- Income Restrictions: Market-rate


**Incentives:** Capped at \$1.5M per builder/developer (\$2M for first time all-electric builder/developers)

- All-Electric New Construction
- Energy Storage
- Bonus Incentives: Envelope and Mechanical packages, DAC/HTR, Load management
- Technical Assistance



# **CaIEHP OBJECTIVES**

Motivate adoption of all-electric new construction practices and prepare homes to respond to time-of-use electrical prices



## **BASE ELIGIBILITY**

100% all-electric residential buildings and the following:



Heat Pump Space Heating



Heat Pump Water Heating



Induction Cooking



Thermostatic Mixing Valves



Segregated Circuits



Smart Thermostats



## MANUFACTURED HOUSING

Requires all-electric with no primary resistance technology

#### **Each unit must include:**

- Heat pump space and water heating
- Induction cooking
- Thermostatic mixing valve
- Smart thermostat








## **ENERGY STORAGE**

\$10M dedicated to incentivize energy storage

#### **Incentives:**

- \$250/kWh for battery storage
- \$300/kWh for battery storage in all-electric reach code jurisdictions
- Thermal energy storage incentives coming soon





# **BONUSES FOR PRIORITY POPULATIONS**& DISADVANTAGED COMMUNITY EQUITY

#### **Eligible areas include:**

- Census tract designated by CalEnviroScreen 4.0 to identify new construction areas with a high concentration of housingburdened households that are not deed-restricted
- California Native American Tribal Organizations
- California Native American Lands
- Climate Investments Priority Populations
- Urban Heat Islands



## **TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE**

#### **Examples of TA include, but are not limited to:**

- Project planning
- Incentive sharing and/or layering
- Required program documentation
- Energy consultation for Title 24 compliance and energy efficiency
- Project fuel switch from mixed fuel to all-electric
- Low-emissions building design
- Low-emissions technologies

- Energy storage
- Electric vehicle service equipment
- Project-related local government all-electric building code and permit requirements
- Virtual or in-person site visits as necessary



## **BONUS MEASURES**

#### **Envelope Package**

 Prescriptive walls and attics prerequisite, a weighted average of all glazing ≤ 0.26U-factor, and air sealing down to an ACH50 ≤ 3.0

#### **Mechanical Package**

HVAC and water heating must meet CEE Tier 1 requirements

#### **Envelope + Mechanical Adder**

 Additional incentive for taking both the envelope and mechanical bonuses

#### **Heat Pump Pool Heater**

Utilizing heat pump pool heating for multifamily properties planning pools

#### **Manufactured Housing**

Projects receiving ENERGY STAR certification



#### **BONUS MEASURES**

Smart Panel or Hard-wired Home Energy Management System (HEMS) Installation

**Heat Pump Water Heater Controller Installation** 

#### Resiliency / Demand Response Ready Adder



#### **INCENTIVE SHARING & LAYERING**

#### Eligibility is based on:

- Where projects are located
- Which electric utility provider will provide service to the project



Our team will help maximize incentives for each project through sharing and layering
